New Features launched on iGOT Karmayogi Platform


In his Keynote Address, the Hon'ble Minister congratulated the Capacity Building Commission and Karmayogi Bharat in enabling the institutionalization of capacity-building of government workforce. **Dr Jitendra Singh** emphasized on making capacity-building relevant to the Indian context and exhorted all government officials to accord the highest priority to behavioural change and integrity.

On the occasion, the Hon'ble Minister felicitated top performing Ministries, Departments, and Organizations on iGOT.

Further, the top performing learners who had completed the highest number of courses on the platform from various Departments and Organizations were also felicitated.

The Hon'ble Minister also launched three new features on the iGOT Karmayogi Platform

- Assessments
- Surveys
- Dashboard.

Driving Mission Karmayogi through iGOT Platform



Delivering the welcome address, **Shri Abhishek Singh** (CEO, Karmayogi Bharat) briefed all guests on the roadmap over the upcoming months about the iGOT Karmayogi Platform and also shared some key insights on the portal.

He shared that the iGOT portal currently had learners across the government spectrum. and had helped to substantially democratize learning in line with the Mission's core objective of transitioning from rule-based to role-based governance.

In his special address on 'Excellence



in Public Service through Alignment of Talent along Digital Possibilities', **Shri S. Ramadorai** (Chairperson, Karmayogi Bharat) spoke at length on how the civil service as the 'steel-frame' of the nation has been instrumental in driving the India growth story.

He touched upon the national imperative for public service professionals to imbibe skills tailored for Industry 4.0. While catering to rising citizens' expectations for accountability, and transparency he highlighted how iGOT was seeking to leverage Al, Machine Learning and Data Analytics. The objective is



to create the vibrant ecosystem for civil servants to acquire new skills and competencies.

Speaking on 'Relevance of Capacity Building through iGOT Karmayogi in Good Governance', Smt S. Radha Chauhan (Secretary, DoPT) noted the commendable progress achieved by Ministries, Departments, Organizations and learners over the last few months. She shared about the qualitative enhancement brought about by a shift from input-based, supplydriven training to demand-based capacity-building.

Evolving Capacity-Building in
India under **Mission Karmayogi**

Shri Adil Zainulbhai (Chairperson, Capacity Building Commission), in his address, touched upon the core structure of Mission Karmayogi, and how the two organs of Capacity Building Commission and Karmayogi Bharat are working in harmony to accelerate learning among civil servants. He also emphasized on the scalability of the digital learning model, and the quality assurance of training

resources ensured by the iGOT Karmayogi Platform.

Addressing the gathering, Shri Hemang Jani (Secretary, Capacity Building Commission) made a presentation on the National Capacity Building Framework for Civil Servants being currently established by the Capacity Building Commission.





Perspectives from leading Ministries, Departments, and Organizations



Shri K. Rajaraman (Secretary, Department of Telecommunications) spoke in depth on how Mission Karmayogi had infused new thought and new direction to take forward capacity-building for all civil servants. He shared how courses on behavioural competencies could generate key impact in ensuring effective public service delivery. In his address, Shri Rajaraman also acknowledged the commendable performance of BSNL's learners on iGOT.

Representing the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, **Shri Sudhansh Pant** (Secretary, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways) highlighted how the iGOT platform was helping transform the training ecosystem in India by making quality learning resources available for all in the government work force. He shared the Ministry had engaged several Centres of Excellence for the purpose of imparting quality training via iGOT, including- IIT Madras, Indian Maritime University, and JNPT-Antwerp Port Training Centre.





Shri Anish Dayal (Director-General, ITBP) shared how courses on Artificial Intelligence, Grievance Handling, Government e-Marketplace, Cyber Security, Emerging Technologies, Office Procedure, Stress Management had been most popular with learners of Indo-Tibetan Border Police. He also acknowledged how the uptake of courses has been particularly encouraging for learners posted in remote, high-altitude, and vulnerable locations.

BREAK OUT SESSIONS

In the iGOT Karmashala Breakout Sessions, discussions were deliberated around three major key areas with the objective to take insights and best practices

- Content Creation & Curation to take inside and best practices for enhanced learner engagement.
- Product Roadmap to take insights on functionality expectations of Ministries/ Departments from iGOT,
- Adaptation of iGOT in ministries, Departments, States, CTI's to increase awareness and update of courses by civil servants.







CONTENT CREATION & CURATION:

Dr R Balasubramaniam, Member-HR, Capacity Building Commission, highlighted identifying target learners as the first step in providing world class content to the learners. He mentioned three areas to work around-

- 1. Can the learner relate to the course?
- 2. Is the subject relevant to the learner?
- 3. Can the learning be applied?

Shri Hemang Jani, Secretary, Capacity Building Commission, affirmed that the optimal way of content creation was to utilize the existing resources and improvise the existing content. He advised creating small modules which would facilitate in making additional changes based on real time inputs.

Smt Rajul Bhatt, Joint Secreatry, DoPT, underlined the identification of the department needs in the Annual Capacity Building Plan and filing the relevant gaps with the courses.





IGOT KARMAYOGI PLATFORM PRODUCT ROADMAP:

Dr. Niramljeet Singh Kalsi, Board Member, Karmayogi Bharat, elaborated the iGOT Platform should in the near future provide courses and fulfil the need for different set of skills i.e., soft skills, life skills, technical skills, and job skills.

Shri Adil Zainulbhai, Chairman, Capacity Building Commission, established

that there was a need for practical, easily available learning for beginners related to eminent topics with an'anytime, anywhere' learning feature.

Shri Pankaj Bansal, Board Member, Karmayogi Bharat, dwelled upon the need to fulfil the demands of a large scale diverse audience like the Police, CRPF, etc.; and to build a quality experience with a better platform, a better administrative experience, and a better user experience.

Smt Debjani Ghosh, Board Member, Karmayogi Bharat, highlighted the need to create courses on the latest technology i.e., Al, ChatGPT, to focus on Data Security and building a socially inclusive platform.

STRATEGY FOR ADOPTION OF IGOT IN MINISTRIES, DEPARTMENTS, STATES & CTI's:

Various strategies, suggestions, requests and information were deliberated in line with adoption of iGOT in the Government sector:

- A video on how to use the platform in vernacular languages should be made available on the iGOTKarmayogi Platform.
- Circulation of newsletters to provide regular updates.

- A notification to be sent to the learners whenever a new course is launched.
- Incentive should be linked with course completion.
- Courses to be listed out in alphabetical order.
- Specialized courses for Medical Professionals, on Duties of Board of Directors in a Government Organization, on FDI, etc.











CONCLUDING REMARKS:

The major objective and idea behind the iGOT Karmashala were to understand the significance of capacity building among civil servants and leveraging the iGOT Karmayogi platform, to assist government officials in becoming

more innovative, professional, technology-enabled, and developing correct attitude. With new features being introduced and developments happening around the iGOT Karmayogi Platform, Karmayogi Bharat seeks to bring

about reform at the individual, institutional, and process levels. Being an integral component in driving the Mission, the iGOT platform is on the way to shaping a new generation of civil servants from Karmachari to Karmayogi.
