iGOT KARMAYOGI

iGOT Karmayogi is a comprehensive online platform devised to guide civil service officials in their capacity building journey. Through these, iGOT seeks to advance online, face-to-face, and blended learning; facilitating discussions through topical forums, managing career paths, and enabling reliable assessments that credibly signal competencies of officials.



1) DISCUSSION HUB : It serves as a forum for learners to share and exchange ideas, as well as interact and engage with peers on subjects/areas of common interest. An official registered on iGOT portal can learn from discussions on existing forum threads or, start a new discussion thread to gain insights from others who have solved similar problems.

2) NETWORK HUB : Functions as a forum for connecting with colleagues engaged in government service. True to iGOT's core as a solutioning platform, learners can make use of this hub to solve problems by tapping into each other's experiences, and competencies across fields.

3) EVENT HUB : Positioning as a solutioning space for all of government learners to join online or, in-person topical events as and when they are organized by Ministries, Government Departments, and Organizations. It is well suited to advance peer-to-peer interaction, collaboration, and drive relevant conversations around a variety of themes.

4) LEARNING HUB : It seeks to enable, and empower civil servants to learn anytime, anywhere, across any-device, and accordingly help in bridging their competency gaps by availing the extensive learning products and

resources offered on iGOT. Nearly 360 courses from a variety of government, as well as non-government institutions/ organizations are available to learners.

5) COMPETENCY HUB : Useful for public officials in identifying their competency gaps, it helps in signalling expertise, and systematically plan capacity building efforts by employing the vital instruments of FRAC (Framework for Roles, Activities, and Competencies), and WAT (Work Allocation Tool). The hub also seeks to provide HR managers with insights on

competency deficiencies at individual or departmental levels, enabling them to take corrective action.

6) CAREER HUB : Positioned to help learners in exploring career opportunities, the Career Hub allows civil servants to search for vacancies, assess their competency fitment, and signal their professional goals. This Hub helps HR managers in tailoring their strategic decisions based on the available competency data, and reconcile officials with suited vacancies.

iGOT KARMAYOGI APP

In line with the core goal of anywhere, anytime, and any-device learning, the iGOT Karmayogi App, developed by NIC, was recently launched for Android, and iOS. With more than 12,000+ downloads across Google Play Store, and App Store over the last few months, the App seeks to present all learners with the experience of mobile learning for enhancing their overall competencies through the 6 hubs (Learning, Discussion, Competency, Event, Career, and Network)

available on the platform. Serving as a solutioning space for all of Government, learners can log-in from their devices on the App, and browse through a variety of courses suited for their roles.

Along with the web platform, the iGOT Karmayogi App aspires to drive the objective of transforming the Indian civil service, and help in catalysing the change from rule-based to role-based governance

MISSION KARMAYOGI

Designed as a six-pronged initiative, NPCSCB lays emphasis on developing the potential of officials, training institutes and the government. It re-energizes key aspects in the capacity building and HR management structure in government, including regulation and governance.

The Programme will cover all civil servants (including contractual employees) across different ministries, departments, organizations and agencies of the Union Government.

Mission Karmayogi aims to create a competent civil service

rooted in Indian ethos, with a shared understanding of India's priorities, working in harmonization for effective and efficient public service delivery. The Mission seeks to keep the civil service at the center of all change, empowering them to deliver in challenging environments. The focus of NPCSCB is also on enhancing the government-citizen interaction, with officials becoming enablers for citizens and business, with development of Behavioural-functional-domain competencies leading to ease of living and ease of doing business.

Thus, by design, Mission Karmayogi adopts a citizen-centric approach for civil service reforms.



KARMAYOGI TALKS

Karmayogi Talks is envisioned under the aegis of Mission Karmayogi. This is an interactive talk session with distinguished experts and practitioners. They excel in the fields of public policy, capacity-building, governance, academia, civil society and technology. Karmayogi Talks debuted on 2nd January, 2023 on the official YouTube channel of Karmayogi Bharat.

Organized in partnership with IIM-Bangalore, and Wadhvani Foundation on 12th January, 2023, the session, moderated by Shri Abhishek Singh

The introductory episode featured **Dr R. Balasubramaniam** (Member- HR, Capacity Building Commission) as the speaker on the subject, '**Transition from Karmachari to Karmayogi**'. Moderated by Shri Abhishek Singh (CEO, Karmayogi Bharat), the session familiarized the participants on the key facets of the National Program for Civil Services Capacity Building (Mission Karmayogi), transition from rule-based to role-based

governance, and the goal of nurturing a government workforce that is smart, skilled, responsive, and citizen-friendly in its approach. The post-talk, online Q&A session saw a lively discussion on the subject with participants from across Ministries, Government Departments, State, and District Administrations, including-BSNL, National Test House, and Bodoland Administrative Staff College.

In conversation with Shri Praveen Pardeshi (Member, Capacity Building Commission), and Shri Abhishek Singh (CEO, Karmayogi Bharat), **Prof Patrick Whitney**, and **Mr. Andre Nogueira**, from Harvard T.H Chan School of Public Health, were the featured speakers for the third episode of Karmayogi Talks. The session revolved primarily around the key question of **'Design Change- Preparing Civil Leaders to Cope with Uncertainty When Information Changes Faster Than It Can Be Understood'**, and covered aspects of design change evolution, innovation gap, design awareness, design competencies, and value webs.

Revolving around the topic of **'Future of Work'**, the most recent episode of Karmayogi Talks featured **Mr. Jamie McAuliffe** (Founding Director, Global Opportunity Youth Network, The Aspen Institute) as the speaker in conversation with Shri Praveen Pardeshi (Member, Capacity Building Commission), Shri Abhishek Singh (CEO, Karmayogi Bharat), and Priyanka Agarwal (Consultant, Karmayogi Bharat). A wide set of issues, like - youth & women employment, entrepreneurship, creation of local job opportunities, and automation, were covered through the course of the talk.

On 31st January, 2023, Karmayogi Talks was live-streamed featuring noted development economist, and Nobel Laureate Prof Michael Kremer as the speaker, in conversation with Shri Manoj Ahuja (Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, and Farmers' Welfare), Shri Parveen Pardeshi (Member, Capacity Building Commission), and Shri Abhishek Singh (CEO, Karmayogi Bharat). The talk focused on **'Driving Innovation in Agriculture, and Water Resources (with particular emphasis on the Jal Jeevan Mission scheme) by Leveraging India's Digital Infrastructure.'** Aspects of Digital Agriculture, like- Weather Forecasting, Mobile Phone Advisory, Soil Health Cards, as well as ideas like, establishment of Government Innovation Units were touched upon through the course of the discussion.
